###### **Branch Chief, Confidential (2005 to 2008)**

Organized branch intelligence analysis of worldwide Iranian and Shia extremism and terrorism, including Hizballah group. Prepared analytical reports for most senior government leaders, including President and Cabinet. Trained and led up to 11 high-performing personnel, including inter-agency teams, in counterterrorist support for federal, state, and local government. Created outreach programs to enhance relations with counterparts across organizations for national-level support of military forces. Maintained expertise in target groups and regions to forecast analysis requirements. Retired as Lieutenant Colonel.

###### **Specific Accomplishments:**

- Built capabilities of new organization from ground up to produce over 150 analyses for Cabinet-level government leaders, including over 30 directly for President Bush.
- Earned certificate of commendation from Director for performance leading joint analytic team with CIA and FBI during 2006 Hizballah crisis.
- Devised crisis management and notification processes for Center to ensure emergency readiness.
- Pioneered counterterrorism capacity analysis function in Directorate of Intelligence.
- Led national intelligence community analysis during capture of Iranian Qods Force officers in Iraq, extensively impacting US policy development and military operations.

###### **Strategic Advisor, United States Central Command (2003 to 2005)**

Analyzed policy options for General John Abizaid to support advice for Secretary of Defense, affecting more than 200,000 military staff operating in Southwest Asia, including Iraq and Afghanistan. Created military, political, social, and economic criteria to evaluate insurgent activities in Iraq. Obtained analysis from academic and policy experts. Researched and prepared reports to meet extremely tight deadlines.

###### **Specific Accomplishments:**

- Hand-selected as liaison to a multinational planning staff from 8 foreign militaries for US operations in Horn of Africa, increasing planning capacity and ensuring alignment of efforts.
- Streamlined management functions into single chain of command and enhanced efficiency with new structures and processes for strategic communications.
- Recommended crisis response measures for Iraq adopted by General Abizaid.

**Iraq Air Defense Team Chief, United States Central Command (2001 to 2003)**

Led cross-service intelligence team of 8 analyzing Iraqi Air Defense forces, including priorities for long-term strategic analysis, intelligence collection operations, and targeting of forces. Delivered real-time intelligence support enabling completion of 30,000+ combat missions with zero losses to radar-guided missiles for the first time since introduction in Vietnam.

**Specific Accomplishments:**

- Successfully integrated analysis by US Central Command, US Air Force, and national intelligence community prior to Operation Iraqi Freedom, consolidating efforts of 7 organizations on 3 continents.
- Lowered rapid targeting cycle from 3 hours to 30 minutes while eliminating duplication of effort that had occurred during Operation Desert Storm and Kosovo air campaign.
- Reduced threat against air forces by 50% with air defense targeting studies and priorities.

**Operations Support & Force Protection Branch Chief (1999 to 2000)**

Trained and led 18 staff in tactics analysis and intelligence support delivered to 2 numbered Air Forces, 6 flying wings, and 20 installations for air operations in Sub-Saharan Africa and Europe, including Kosovo and Bosnia. Oversaw 24-hour Intelligence Watch Center with 4 teams monitoring 130 countries, and force protection group producing theater-wide risk assessments and protection measures for Air Force assets.

**Specific Accomplishments:**

- Enabled casualty-free completion of over 38,000 missions in 78 days for Operation Allied Force.
- Cut certification time 50% with new training program for watch center team chiefs and personnel.
- Created concept of operations used to brief Secretary of Defense and Chairman of Joint Chiefs of Staff by Commander of United States European Command.
- Led intelligence and force protection support for President Clinton's European state visits.
